To all relevant parties:

At the February 23rd meeting of the Judicial Board, the board delivered a decision following the hearing request filed against the ASWOU Senate for violations of Oregon Public Meeting Law and the ASWOU Governing Documents. The Judicial Board found the ASWOU Senate in violation of Article IV Section 1, subsection a of the ASWOU Bylaws:

“The Senate shall meet at least three times monthly, with the exception of the months of December, June, July, August, and September, or when the regularly scheduled meeting of the Senate is on a day when the university is closed. The Senate shall not meet during finals week, except for special meetings, and is not required to fulfill its meeting quota during the months which include finals week.”

Per the failure to meet three times in the month of January, the Judicial Board sanctioned the 52nd ASWOU Senate to a probationary period until the end of Spring 2022. Should the ASWOU Senate fail to meet the above outlined requirements, they will be subjected to further sanctions under the ASWOU Judicial Board.
