Pursuant to Graduate Regulations related to Accelerated Undergraduate to Master's Pathway (AUMP) (G-8), the Early Childhood Education, M.S.E, and the Education, Education, Early Childhood Studies, B.S. establish the following articulation agreement to allow students to accelerate their attainment of the Early Childhood Studies, M.S.E by beginning master's level coursework during their undergraduate career.

The Education, Early Childhood Education, B.S. agrees to accept and apply up to 15 credits of graduate coursework from the Early Childhood Studies, M.S.E degree program towards courses in the Education, Early Childhood Education, B.S.

A maximum of 15 credits of courses below is to be used for core courses towards the graduate program approved by the Early Childhood Education advisor:

- ED 570 substitute for ED 470
- SPED 646 substitutes for SPED 446
- ED 566 substitutes for ED 466
- SPED 630 substitutes for SPED 430
- SPED 623 substitutes for SPED 423
- ED 585 substitutes for ED 485
