- 1. What is the justification for changing the course from lower division to upper division?
- 2. What is the content change to support the change of course level?
- 3. What is the difference in the syllabi for 210 and 310?
- 4. What is the difference in learning outcomes for 210 and 310?
- 5. Why is 310 on the schedule already? What justification was used for the temporary course change and why is it not included in the permanent course change?
- 6. The proposal says that

"LING 210 is a required course in Teacher Education, ASL and English/Writing/Linguistics. A course number change does not affect these programs. On-going LACC/GE revisions render the status of this course moot for future GE/LACC"

Since this proposal affects current DSPS and DEL articulation agreements, this seems to be an overstatement. What consultation was done with DSPS and DEL?
