On Friday, February 1, Dr. Nicole Stokes-DuPass will be coming to WOU to conduct an all-day interactive workshop on diversity, equity and inclusion targeted toward campus faculty leadership. We can have up to 50 participants and we are encouraging the participation of all deans, division chairs, department heads, and other faculty members in leadership or decision-making roles.
