 - Extended conversations with Monmouth mayor and city police
 - Reviewed and approved by the WOU Parking Review Committee students, staff, and faculty (low representation)
 - Affordability and reduced parking on city streets were considerations
 - WOU student and employee accessibility to buildings considered
 - Safety considered blue emergency phones are current, campus safety can provide escorts for anyone ('escort' can be via phone, patrol car, or walk)
 - No permits required after 6 pm, can move vehicles to closer lots
 - Encouraged use of loading zones, calls to campus safety for notice, pay metered spaces
