1. *Fall 2020 Course Scheduling.* Priority registration begins this week and regular registration begins next week. We have a mix of in-person, hybrid and both online delivery modalities. We are scheduling classrooms at 42% of maximum capacity as that was what our modeling showed would facilitate 6 feet of distance between people. We are still awaiting guidance from OHA but this conservative approach will allow for Fall 2020 registration.
