### 3. Proposal to Modify/Merge Program Outcomes and Learning Outcomes

Camila Gabaldón has once again come up with a way to make our lives easier. The current system for submitting and updating program outcomes and major/minor/certificate learning outcomes is not currently working. For most of us, there is not a clear distinction between program outcomes and learning outcomes, and there have been several situations where individuals have submitted updates, thinking that they are updating the program outcomes when they mean to update the learning outcomes and vice-versa.

Camilia is proposing:

- To gather data about what is listed for each type of outcome.
- When there are discrepancies, she will work with departments to reconcile which versions are the correct ones and update the entries for each.
- When the discrepancies are reconciled, she update the outcomes for the Program Outcomes page and work with the Registrar's office to make sure the catalog is correct
- She will update the curriculum system as follows:
  - Eliminate the separate path for updating Program Outcomes only
  - Move the current table structure for updating Program Outcomes to the path for updating programs and rename it to "Program Learning Outcomes". This entry format provides parseable data that can be repurposed for the program outcomes page, course goal alignments, and the catalog.
  - Create a field that automatically formats the data in the table of Program Learning Outcomes into a textual format that can be copied and pasted into the catalog, for use by the Registrar's Office.

FSEC has been working with Dr. Mike Baltzley to discuss ongoing issues with assessment. FSEC has decided to conduct an anonymous survey that will be sent to department chairs and program coordinators at the beginning of Spring term. The data will be reviewed by FSEC only, and we will issue a report to Dr. Baltzley with recommendations about the support, resources, time, and feedback faculty have about our current assessment practices. Our hope is that consulting faculty will lead to improvements in our assessment processes.

#### 6. Search for an Interim President

As you may have seen in the email from Betty Komp, the BOT is moving forward with a search for an interim president. The search committee will have two seats for faculty members. I have been asked to gather possible candidates for these seats. If you would like to nominate yourself or someone else, please let me know ASAP. *I must forward all nominations by March 1, so I would prefer to receive them no later than Friday, February 26.* 

It is important to note that there will be significant activity in March and anyone that serves will need to have a relatively flexible schedule to accommodate meetings throughout March and, perhaps April. Further, anyone on the advisory committee will be required to sign statements regarding confidentiality and conflict of interest.
