Change Grading Standards (<u>U-7</u>) to read:

Satisfactory: Students have the option to take designated courses on a Satisfactory-No Credit basis; the satisfactory level to pass is defined as equivalent to a grade of C- or better.

Create Satisfactory/No Credit Grade Mode (U-12)

Undergraduate students may elect to take designated courses on Satisfactory/No Credit (S/NC) basis. S/NC grading operates as follows:

- A grade of S may apply towards general education and elective requirements.
- Programs will determine which, if any, requirements in their major, minor, concentration, and/or certificate can be fulfilled with a grade of S.
 - Each major, minor, concentration, and/or certificate will have a notation regarding the use of S grades in meeting requirements for that program.
- Students must elect the S/NC grade mode by Friday week-7 of the term.
 - An equivalent deadline applies to Summer term sessions.
- A grade of C- or higher is equivalent to a grade of S.
- A grade below C- is equivalent to a grade of NC.
 - NC grades do not fulfill any requirements.
- Only 36 credits, with a grade of S, may be applied towards requirements.
