Note: Formal admission is required for all students seeking the BA/BS degree in Psychology. Prior to application for admission to the Psychology major, applicants must complete the PSY 201, 202, 301 sequence or its equivalent and achieve Sophomore standing (45 or more credit hours). Students will be admitted to the Psychology major who meet the following criteria: 1) a GPA of 2.67 in all Psychology courses completed and 2) a cumulative GPA of 2.5 for all college work.							
Students earning a BS degree in Psychology are also required to take at least 12 hours of Math/Computer Science/Quantitative Literacy courses according to the following specifications: PSY 467, 468; any Math course above MTH 105 with the exception of MTH 243, and any CS class above CS 101.
